Indoor Flying

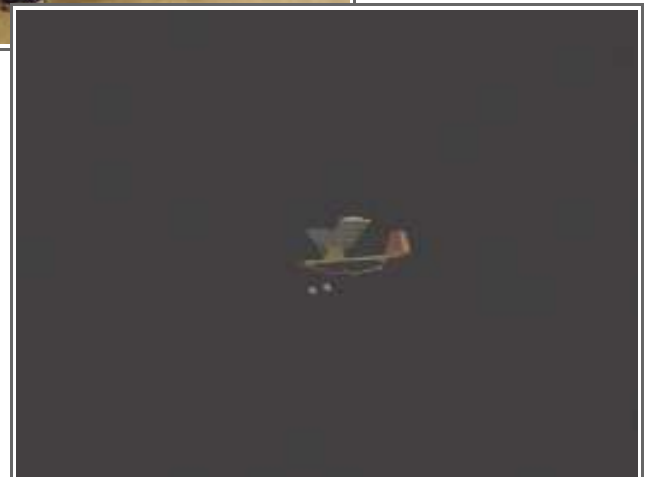

Frank sent several photos of his latest project: A **SIG SeaLane** and he says:

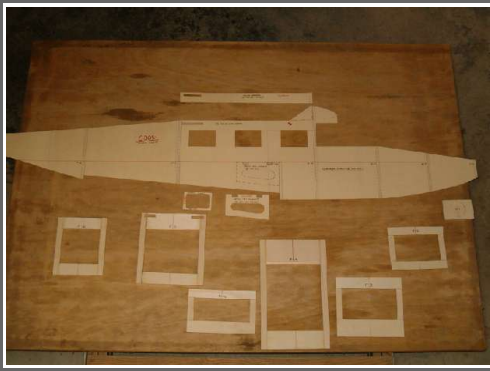


“Flew nice off land and I hope it does as good on water”
